

## The ICD-10 Transition is Coming. Are YOU ready?

### **WHEN**

The implementation date proposed by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) for the transition to ICD-10 is **October 1, 2015**.

### **WHO**

All entities covered by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) must be able to successfully conduct health care transactions using ICD-10 diagnosis and inpatient procedure codes by the ICD-10 implementation date.

### **THE IMPACT**

ICD-9 diagnosis and inpatient procedure codes cannot be used for services provided on or after the implementation date.

Please be aware that if you do not comply with changing from ICD-9 to ICD-10, claims received after October 1, 2015 without ICD-10 codes will be denied.

The ICD-10-CM revision has more than 68,000 diagnostic codes, compared to the 13,000 found in ICD-9-CM. The revision also includes twice as many categories making it more specific in identifying treatment. This is a significant change and your readiness is critical.

### **TESTING**

Testing has begun. Alameda Alliance for Health has contracted with EDIF ECS to use their collaborative testing tools in order to streamline ICD-10 testing with Providers. The Alliance expects to be ICD-10-ready by September 18, 2015. A critical goal for us is to do ICD-10 end-to-end testing with our “ready and willing” providers to test their claims. These ICD-10 test claims will be adjudicated in our ICD-10 ready test system, with detailed reports provided back to the providers.

### **EVALUATE YOUR READINESS**

Alameda Alliance for Health sent out ICD-10 Readiness Surveys to a large portion of our partners, and we have sent out communications addressing ICD-10 and what the expectations are from our provider community.
