



Important Update on CalHealthCares Program

At Alameda Alliance for Health (Alliance) we value our dedicated provider partner community. We have an important program update that we would like to share with you.

In an ongoing effort to improve health throughout our state and community, the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has partnered with Physicians for a Healthy California (PHC) to create the CalHealthCares Program. This program is a medical student loan repayment program that incentivizes physicians and dentists for participating in the Medi-Cal program and promotes increasing access to care for Medi-Cal patients. Through this program, eligible recently graduated healthcare providers may apply for a loan repayment in exchange for an increased patient caseload comprised of Medi-Cal beneficiaries.

The second application cycle for CalHealthCares will be available Monday, January 13, 2020.
